

TORNADO STRIKES THREE HILLS CAMPSITE

A small tornado ripped through a crowded campground near Three Hills Saturday night damaging several campsites.

No one was hurt—but one woman was treated for shock after she watched the wind carry off the canvas cover of the camper where her baby was sleeping.

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Campers at the Frog Gap provincial campground, 2½ miles from Three Hills watched as a funnel shaped cloud broke off from a storm and slammed into several campers and tents.

An RCMP estimate places the cost of the damage at \$2,000.

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RCMP say the campground was filled with families of the players in a 16-team weekend baseball tournament.

Police say the tornado lifted the roof off one hard-topped camper and carried it into a car. Several canvas-topped campers were stripped and one tent was lifted 100 feet into the air.
