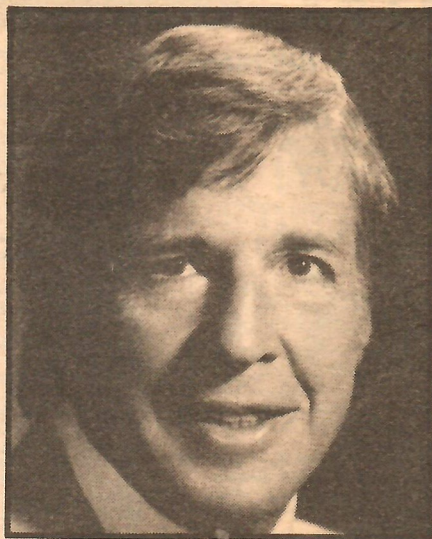
Capozzi to dinner
